





USMTS visits Off Road Speedway in mid-week special

Off Road Speedway offered a rare mid-week special night of racing Wednesday, hosting the United States Modified Touring Series race cars for the first time.

The modified series, which describes itself as “the most popular and most widely-used type of race car circling America’s dirt tracks today,” begins its 26th season in 2025.

The USMTS asserts that “no less than 20,000 men and women compete nationwide on any given weekend,” adding that “more than 1,500 different drivers from 36 states have competed in USMTS events at 55 unique dirt tracks in 15 different states.”

On Wednesday, 20 “A” mods participated in individual two-lap qualifying runs, then three 10-lap heats to determine the lineup for a 35-lap “A” feature, which was won by Rodney Sanders of Happy, Texas.

Sanders, starting on the outside of the second row, chased early race leader Gary Christian for the initial seven laps as the pair pulled away from the field.

Sanders got his chance to pull even, then gained enough momentum on the high side of turn three to pass Christian on the outside coming out of turn four.

Sanders maintained the lead the rest of the race, despite having to navigate lapped traffic with 23 laps remaining.

Behind Sanders and Christian, a three-car battle for third waged among Reece Solander (Emporia, Kan.), Joe Chisholm (Osage, Iowa), and Tanner Mullens (Wichita, Kan.) — with each driver gaining the advantage to hold the position temporarily.

Without a caution to close the field behind them, Sanders won by several car lengths, with Christian — of Broken Bow, Oklahoma — securing second well ahead of third-place finisher Chisholm.

Mullens finished fourth with Tyler Davis of Haysville, Kansas, rounding out the top five. Sanders — who has won the USMTS national title five times — is currently the series points leader with Mullens, Chisholm and Christian all among the top 10.

Also competing Wednesday night were the IMCA SportMods, with 19 cars participating in a 20-lap “A” feature.

Justin Klynsma of Hospers, Iowa, broke to the front from his starting position on the outside of row one and led the rest of the race for the win, followed the entire journey by Columbus driver David Johnson.

Behind Johnson’s second-place finish — with a late move following the feature’s only caution, which occurred with two laps left — was Willy Kirk of Sloan, Iowa.

Kirk was able to steadily make his way from the outside of the fifth row throughout the race and eventually into contention for third with Pierce driver Cameron Meyer.

The caution, which created a green-white-checkered finish, allowed Kirk to first challenge Meyer on one lap, then pass on the outside of turn four during the next to earn third.

Meyer then edged Mason Day of Farmersville, Texas, to determine fourth and fifth place, respectively.

Also racing were 14 cars representing the Good Old Time Racing Association.


