Off Road Speedway ends 2025 season with Wyatt Frisch Memorial

The Wyatt Frisch Memorial — a 30-lap IMCA Hobby Stock feature race — along with championship night in the other five regular divisions wrapped up the racing season at Off Road Speedway on Saturday night.

Points champions at the track for the season were Norfolk's Chase Osborne (IMCA Late Models), Neligh's Cameron Wilkinson (IMCA Stock Cars), Jason Wilkinson of Neligh (IMCA Hobby Stocks), Cameron Meyer of Pierce (IMCA SportMods), Braden Janssen of Yankton (Pro Stock 4) and Damon Arehart of Neligh (Crown Vic).

Winning the 30-lap Wyatt Frisch Memorial and a \$2,005 purse in the Hobby Stocks class was Brayden Hurley of Grand Island. Hurley began the race in the pole position but saw Dakota Spann immediately dart into the lead ahead of him. Despite an early caution, Hurley found himself in a four-car battle with Dalton Young and Wyatt Lehman for much of the race. The field gradually spread out behind those four cars until a second caution occurred with eight laps remaining, but even then Spann maintained his advantage as Hurley moved ahead of Young with Lehman holding fourth place. As the cars ticked off the final five laps, Hurley made his move to the front, passing Spann and taking the lead. Suddenly, a car spun out behind the leaders as they prepared to head into the final lap, setting up a caution and restart for a green-white-checked finish — a dash for cash with the cars in a single-file alignment. Hurley held on for the win, while Spann of Wayne took second and Albion racer Young finished third.

The IMCA Late Models "A" feature became a competition between cousins Beau Johnson of Plainview and Devin Johnson of Bloomfield. Within the first two laps, Beau Johnson maneuvered into the lead from the second row and remained out front, holding a straightaway-length advantage for the entirety of the 20-lap race, while Eric Vanosdall, Devin Johnson and Anthony Roth fought over second place behind him. Roth, of Columbus, held the position for eight laps until Devin Johnson passed him and quickly closed the gap between himself and his cousin, losing to Beau Johnson by a few feet at the finish line while Roth took third.

Chuck Sands of Neligh saved his best for last by winning the IMCA Stock Cars feature. Neil Bruns broke into the lead from his starting position on the outside of row one while Sands, who started on the pole, took up the pursuit for the first nine laps. Sands got his chance to take the lead with seven laps left and took it as the cars left turn four with Dylan Haney following him to temporarily grab second place. Sands held on during the final five laps while Justin Addison of Meadow Grove won the battle with Haney for second, forcing Haney of Fremont to settle for third place.

Colby Langenberg of Norfolk moved all the way from the fourth row to win the IMCA SportMods "A" feature. Langenberg didn't get to the front until a caution with four laps left provided the opportunity. Until then, Langenberg was in a competition with Willy Kirk, Jonathan Jensen and Riley Osantowski. Ultimately, Kirk of Sloan, Iowa, earned second place by moving just ahead of Norfolk driver Jensen, who edged Osantowski for third.

When the start of the Pro Stock 4 feature race resulted in two damaged cars and a reshuffling of the starting grid for an ensuing restart, Trent Reed of Mondamin, Iowa, moved quickly into the lead and promptly established a solid advantage while taking the win. Norfolk drivers Bentley Freeman and Sam Cordner finished in second and third, respectively.

Grayson Stobbe, a 13-year-old from Columbus, notched his sixth win of the season in the Crown Vic "A" feature. Stobbe didn't get the lead until diving his car into the low side of the track entering turn three, pulling alongside and brushing up against race leader Damon Arehart. As the two cars exited turn four and entered the front stretch, Stobbe had the lead for the win.

Arehart of Neligh finished second with Hunter Betzen, a David City driver, taking third place.

A nine-car field representing the Midwest Classic Stockcar Association also raced Saturday at Off Road Speedway. Cody Proskocil of Ord, despite a starting position in the fourth of five rows, got to the front within three laps of the 12-lap feature and earned the win in a 1958 Chevrolet Impala. Finishing second – driving a 1967 Chevy Camaro – was Justin Tilton of Lyons, with Elk City racer Jeff Fallon taking third place in a 1975 Camaro.
