Top finishers in the Stock Cars were Ron Pettitt (3rd), Shawn Primrose (2nd) and winner Travis Barker.

Barker tops the field

The bottom groove was the premium spot to be in the Stock Car division, as there was more grip on the inside lane.

Travis Barker of Sioux City, IA used that and led the final seven laps for the victory.

Norfolk's Ron Pettitt lead the first 11 laps after starting on the pole in the feature. Pettitt protected the inside line as Kyle Wilkinson of Neligh tried to get underneath.

Defending track champion, Jason Wilkinson of Neligh was next to try and get around Pettitt on the inside line.

It would be following the third caution that Barker gave a go at the lead. Barker gave Pettitt a good bump going into turn one. Pettitt missed his

entry into the turn and Barker jumped to the inside to make the pass for the lead with seven laps remaining of the 18-lap feature.

Pettitt worked on the bumper of Barker for most of the final laps but could not regain the lead.

While putting pressure at Barker, Pettitt lost second to nephew Shawn Primrose of Norfolk with three laps remaining.

Primrose finished second and Pettitt was third.

Despite right front suspension damage after a spin, Jason Wilkinson recovered to finish fourth. Tanner Pettitt of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

Winning both his heat race and feature, defending track and national champion, Ramsey Meyer of Pierce is back to pacing the field.

Mark Benedict of Norfolk led the first two laps before Meyer moved out front in the feature race. Parker Vollbrecht of Stanton followed Meyer past Benedict.

For the next seven laps Vollbrecht picked at the lead. Meyer took the win by two-car lengths.

Terry Tritt of York moved into the third spot on lap 7 of the 12-lap feature. Tritt took third, as Benedict finished fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Dylan Kesting of Hoskins.

Wilkinson had tried several different ways to get around Hernandez, but for a moment, he got by Hernandez at the start-finish line to lead lap 10.

Hernandez went back to leading out of turn two, but a caution came out. The field

was lined up from the completion of lap 10, which put the Wilkinson out front on the restart.

Hernandez could not get back by Wilkinson as Wilkinson went onto take the feature victory.

Wyatt Lehman of Norfolk got by Hernandez with three laps remaining for second. Hernandez place third.

Nate DeSive of O'Neill grabbed fourth and Lance Mielke of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

Langenberg leads final lap for victory

A late caution changed the outcome of the SportMod finishing order, as Colby Langenberg of Norfolk picked up the first win of the season.

Battle Creek's Jeremy Gnat led from the drop of the green flag and held off Robbie Thome of Spalding the entire time.

A caution with three-laps remaining in the 20-lap feature, was not what Gnat needed.

On the final restart, Gnat went back to running the bottom, as Thome was running second, Langenberg third and Norfolk's Kyle Prauner fourth.

As the cars exited turn four to take the white flag, Gnat slid up a half-a-car length more than had on exit of turn four.

That opened the door for Thome, who made his move

to the inside of Gnat. The two touched, which then allowed Langenberg to go by on the high side.

Prauner got by Thome and then Gnat on the exit of turn two for second. Langenberg took the win by a car length over Prauner.

Gnat was third. Cameron Meyer of Pierce placed fourth and defending track champion Joey Haase of Norfolk was fifth.

Birkley picks up feature victory

Getting off to a rocky start, the Late Model division had two quick cautions before the race settled down.

Wakefield's Travis Birkley started on the pole and led all 25 laps of the feature to pick up the first win of the season.

Defending track champion Jim Johnson of Plainview ran second for most of the race until a string of cautions scrambled the field as the cars on the high side struggled to get back up to speed.

Norfolk's Chase Osborne managed to get a good restart and edged out Johnson for the

bottom in turn three to make the pass with three laps remaining.

One more caution slowed the field, but Birkley continued to run smooth on the bottom to take the win by a car length over Osborne.

Johnson placed third with his brother, Chris Johnson of Bloomfield taking fourth.

Aurora's Dylan Schmer ran third for most of the race but had to line up on the outside on a late restart. He fell to fourth and then fifth on the final restart.

Travis Birkley (78) races with Dylan Schmer (5s) in their heat race. Birkley later won the feature, as Schmer placed fifth.
