Leighton victorious again

The Super Late Model Racing made a visit to the track last week and put on a show that saw no cautions flags, five lead changes among four drivers.

Coming out on top was Bill Leighton for the second year in a row.

The La Vista driver won the race a year earlier over Nate Beyenhof of Rock Rapids, IA.

Leighton led the final 11 laps of the 35-lap feature that saw a one-groove track develop later in the race.

Brian Kosiski of Papillion led the first seven laps before Corey Zeitner of Omaha used the high side to drive by Kosiski.

Zeitner led the 22-car field for 10 laps as Jesse Sobbing of Malvern, IA got the bottom line working and started making a bid for the lead.

Zeitner moved to

the lower line in three and four then went to the high side in one and two, but he jumped the cushion and Sobbing flashed by on the inside on lap 18.

A lap later Sobbing went to pass a slower car and left the bottom open and Leighton came from the third position to lead the race.

However, Leighton slipped up the track on the next circuit and Sobbing regained the top spot.

Sobbing hugged the inside line for seven laps battling slower cars, who also did not want to give up the bottom.

Catching a slower car at the wrong time, Sobbing slightly drifted up the track enough to allow Leighton to get back inside.

Once out front Leighton never budged from the bottom and followed a slower car for three laps to secure his victory.

Leighton took the win, Sobbing was second and Zeitner placed third. Kosiski captured the fourth spot and Tad Pospisil of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

Zach Zentner of Cedar Rapids lead a line of Off Road Speedway regulars. Zentner was ninth, Jim Johnson of Plainview took 10th, Chase Osborne of Norfolk placed 11th, Chris Johnson of Bloomfield took home 12th and Ben Sukup finished 13th.

Bob Milander of Pierce was the only other regular to run the main event. He finished 19th.

Chris Johnson won the first of two "B" features. Robert Osborne of Norfolk missed the cut at fourth place in the "B" feature.

Sukup placed second in the second "B" feature to advance to the main event.

He pulled away for his second career victory at the track.

Roebuck led the first six laps and then held second for another five laps before a slower car allowed Joey Haase and Justin Addison, both of Norfolk, to get by.

Addison and Haase battled side-by-side for the final three laps. Addison had the edge at the line for second. Haase took third and Roebuck placed fourth.

Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton rounded out the top 5.

Bruns protected his position on the next restart. Bruns held the position until Hans Houfek of Emerson left his transmission and driveshaft on the backstretch to bring out a red flag.

That set up a two-lap shootout between Bruns and Jason Wilkinson. Jason Wilkinson jumped to the outside of Bruns on the restart and the two went side-by-side for the remaining laps.

Jason Wilkinson managed to keep Bruns tight to the inside and exiting turn four on the final lap Jason Wilkinson pulled off the victory.

Bruns was second, Shawn Primrose of Norfolk finished third. Dean Wilkinson grabbed his second top 5 finishing fourth. Rounding out the top 5 was Tiffany Bittner of Norfolk.

Following two quick cautions, the Verdigris driver used the high line to power his way into the lead. Once out front he maintained a two-car cushion from the rest of the field to win his third career feature at the track.
