



Meyer slowly picked his way to the front until he encountered Codie Mielke of Norfolk.


Mielke, who had taken the lead from Mark Benedict of Norfolk on the third lap, kept Meyer at bay for five laps and two restarts.


















Travis Birkley (78) picks up his first win at the track, last week. Birkley led the final eight laps for the win.

On lap eight, the leaders got together field and led the final eight laps for the


Milander and Vogt battled for several more laps exchanging the runner-up position a couple times before Milander made the pass with three laps remaining.


