

Bruns takes third win

Finding the grip he needed on the high side, Troy Bruns of Wayne cruised through the field and would nip Dylan Pospisil of Norfolk at the line to win his third victory of the season.

Brian Osantowski of Columbus led the first two laps, but following the only caution period, Pospisil made the pass for the lead.

Pospisil led 14 laps building a lead as Bruns worked through traffic. It was on lap seven when Bruns moved into second and had clear track to Pospisil.

Slowly lap after lap, Bruns cut the gap and with five laps

left Bruns was on Pospisil's bumper.

Two laps later Bruns moved alongside and for the final laps they were side-by-side.

Bruns had the advantage taking the white flag and on the exit of turn four, Bruns pulled the advantage again for the win.

It was Bruns' third win and seventh top 5. For Pospisil it was his fourth runner-up finish.

Third went to James Roebuck of Genoa and fourth was Kyle Prauner of Norfolk.

Rounding out the top 5 was Matt Haase of Norfolk.

Primrose rolled through second and Chad Bruns of Wayne finished third in a back-up car, after losing an engine in his heat race.

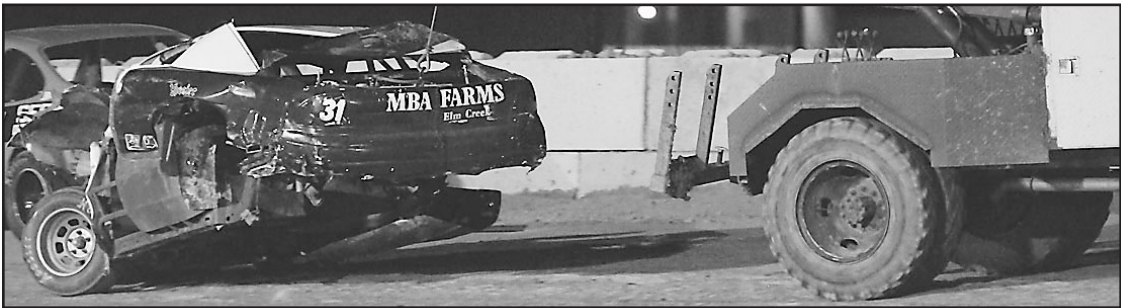
Fourth went to Hadcock and Ron Pettitt of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.
