Prauner outlasts field for win

It had the makings of one of the best competitive races at the track.

However, a caution with three laps remaining changed that.

When it was all over, Kyle Prauner of Norfolk picked up his second win this season.

For most of the 18-lap feature, James Roebuck paced the field with Brian Osantowski of Columbus at his back bumper.

Osantowski made several attempts to get inside the leader but could not clear Roebuck.

As the two battled, Prauner managed to make it a three-car battle. However, slower traffic got out of the way of leader but that put them in Prauner's line.

Twice, Prauner had to back off while challenging for the lead, to avoid lapped traffic. Finally, on lap 16 Prauner cleared Osantowski for second only to have the caution end his bid for the lead.

On the restart, Roebuck, Osantowski and Prauner went three wide on the frontstretch. The three touched. Roebuck came out of the incident with a flat tire bringing out the caution.

Following the restart, Osantowski and Prauner touched several times before Prauner was sent spinning on the final bump between them.

Prauner recovered, however, Osantowski was collected by another car, which ended his night.

That left Prauner leading the field on the final restart with two laps remaining.

Prauner went on to win by five-car lengths when a second-place battle between Colby Langenberg of Norfolk and Cameron Meyer of Pierce began.

Meyer beat Langenberg back to the checkered flag for second. Langenberg finished third. Joey Haase of Norfolk ran a close fourth with Wes Hochstein taking fifth.

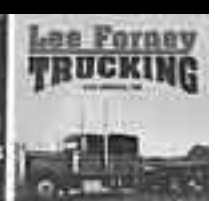
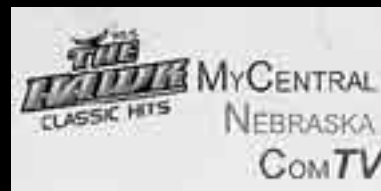
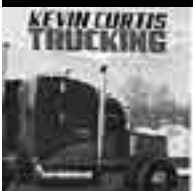


Joey Haase (2) captured a fourth place finish in the feature. His third top 5 this season.

Houfek led the first 11 laps before Kyle Wilkinson got the lead.

That set up a seven-lap shootout between brothers.

Cameron let his brother know he was back there several times, but he could not shake his brother off the bottom.

Kyle Wilkinson took the win and Cameron Wilkinson was second. Hoskinson got by Houfek with four laps remaining to finish third. Houfek finished fourth.

Rounding out the top 5 was Chad Bruns of Wakefield.

race, but cautions kept the field close together. After Wilkinson made the pass for the lead, Buck managed to stay in Wilkinson's wake throughout the final laps.

After the final restart with three laps remaining, Buck had to hold off Tanner Uehling of Norfolk while trying to stay in contact with Wilkinson.

Wilkinson took the win; Buck was second and Uehling placed third. Travis Coover of Neligh finished fourth and Lance Mielke of Norfolk rounded out the top 5.

Eric Vanosdall of Hoskins got around Haase for third before challenging and passing Devin Johnson for second.

When the final caution came out, it set up a seven-lap shootout between Vanosdall

After the restart, Vanosdall jumped the cushion and fell back. Devin Johnson moved ahead of Vanosdall and closed in on his uncle.

However, Vanosdall was not done.

With two laps remaining, Vanosdall was back at the bumper of Devin Johnson. Vanosdall's momentum was stalled by Devin Johnson on the exit of the turns, allowing Devin Johnson to stay ahead of Vanosdall.

Devin Johnson was second and Vanosdall was third by a car length. Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton was fourth and Ben Sukup was fifth.
