

Johnson earns third victory

When Jim Johnson pulled off the track two weeks ago, he thought he finished second.

However, the Plainview driver collected his third win of the season when Travis Birkley of Wakefield was disqualified for the night.

Junior Coover of Norfolk led the first part of the feature, before Birkley got by as Johnson slipped passed his nephew, Devin Johnson of Bloomfield for third.

On the final caution of the night with 10 laps remaining, Jim Johnson was all over Birkley's bumper but was not able to make the pass.

Birkley crossed the line first by a car length. However, the post-race disqualification gave Johnson his third victory of the season and his fourth top 5.

Nelson Vollbrecht of Stanton jumped passed Devin Johnson for third (eventually second with the disqualification) with four laps remaining to cross the line and take his third top 5 of the season.





























